Side Tilt Carriages

Side Tilt Carriage - There are 4 sizes of hook type blade carriages rated by the fork carriage lifting capability. Hook type tine carriages have been consistent.

The carriage bar spacing utilized for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold loads as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo up to 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type forks may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted blades may differ by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the blade. Carriage capacity will be established by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
